Data Privacy Notice for Third Parties

We take your data protection rights and our legal obligations seriously. Your personal data (as defined below) will be treated in a secure and confidential manner and only as set out below or otherwise notified to you in writing.

mitted to protecting your personal data. This privacy policy will tell you about how we look after and use your personal data provided to us, and your privacy rights under data protection regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"; and data protection law made under GDPR) and how those regulations protect you.

For the purpose of the scope of this Privacy Notice, third parties are as follows:

Suppliers: An external natural or legal person/entity outside the Bausch from whom Bausch sources goods or services. This includes, for example:

Distributors and Wholesalers: Any third party that imports and/or resells for its own business purposes Bausch Products (whether or not they provide promotion services for the specific Bausch Products on behalf of Bausch.

The purpose of this Privacy Notice is to clarify the way Bausch is processing personal information of representatives and/or employees as contact persons (data subjects) of a third party or its subcontractor (who will be further referred in this Privacy Notice as "you"). We invite you to carefully read this Privacy Notice, which sets out in which context we are processing information that relates directly or indirectly to you ("personal information") and explains your rights with respect to the processing of your personal information.

Personal Information processed

Personal information may either be directly provided by you or provided by our third party (i.e. the legal entity you work for or on behalf of).

We may collect various types of personal information about you, including:

- (i) your general contact and identification information (e.g. name, first name, last name, gender, date and place of birth, nationality, ID card or passport numbers, email and/or postal address, fixed and/or mobile phone number and car registration number);
- (ii) your function (e.g. title, position and name of company);
- (iii) your financial information (e.g. bank account details, credit worthiness and financial health checks), taxation information (government issued tax ID or account number), information about transactions (delivery and payment history) and background information about your business capabilities and operational performance when you individually act as a third party (e.g. one person company/Sole proprietorship).

In some countries, information relating to a company ("legal person") is also considered as personal information. In such scenarios, if the above-mentioned information collected or provided is specific to a legal entity, we will treat it as personal information in accordance with the applicable data protection law."

The third party you work for will provide the majority of the personal information that we process about you.

Purposes and legal basis

We process the personal data we may have about you for the following purposes:

manage our relationship with you (e.g. through our databases);

- implement tasks in preparation of or to perform existing contracts;
- evidence transactions and ensuring transparency on transfer of value;
- transferring and collecting professional data and information related to drug safety, collecting and evaluating of experiences with our products, advertising and promotion in terms of medicines regulations,
- product testing, analysis and surveying
- provide you with appropriate, adequate and updated information about diseases, drugs as well as our products and services;
- improve the quality of our interactions and services by adapting our offering to your specific needs;
- answer your requests and provide you with efficient support;
- send you communications and information regarding products, therapeutic areas or services that we promote;
- manage, plan and execute communications and interactions with you during the term of the contract and contact you in case of emergency
- keeping records of our activities and payments (e.g. measuring interactions or sales, number of appointments/calls, visits, clinical studies, speaker programs, etc);
- keeping records of free drug samples in line with corporate procedure and local regulations
- preserve the company's economic interests and ensure compliance and reporting (such as complying with our policies and local legal requirements, tax deductions, managing alleged cases of misconduct or fraud; conducting audits and defending litigation);
- manage mergers and acquisitions involving our company;
- for archiving and record-keeping;
- for billing and invoicing;
- any other purposes imposed by law and authorities

We will not process your personal information if we do not have a proper justification foreseen in the law for that purpose. Therefore, we will only process your personal information if:

- we have obtained your prior consent;
- the processing is necessary to perform our contractual obligations towards you or to take pre-contractual steps such as responding to requests for information as part of Bausch due diligence process;
- the processing is necessary to comply with our legal or regulatory obligations; or
- the processing is necessary for our legitimate interests and does not unduly affect your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms.

Please note that, when processing your personal information on this last basis, we always seek to maintain a balance between our legitimate interests and your privacy.

Access to personal data and transfer

In the course of our activities and for the same purposes as those listed in this Privacy Notice, your personal data may be accessed by or transferred to the following categories of recipients, on a need to know basis to achieve such purposes:

- our personnel (including personnel, departments or other companies of the Bausch Health group);
- our suppliers and services providers that provide services and products to us;
- our IT systems providers, cloud service providers, database providers and consultants;
- our business partners who offer products or services jointly with us or with our subsidiaries or affiliates;
- any third party to whom we assign any of our rights or obligations.

The above third parties are contractually obliged to protect the confidentiality and security of your personal data, in compliance with applicable law.

Your personal data can also be accessed by or transferred to any national and/or international regulatory, enforcement, public body or court, where we are required to do so by applicable law or regulation or at their request.

The personal data we collect from you may also be processed, accessed or stored in a country outside the country where Bausch Health is located, which may not offer the same level of protection of personal data.

If we transfer your personal data to external companies in other jurisdictions, we will make sure to protect your personal data in line with applicable legislations.

Protecting your personal data

We have implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures to provide an adequate level of security and confidentiality to your personal data.

Data Retention

We will only retain personal data we may have about you for as long as necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected or to comply with legal or regulatory requirements.

Data Subjects rights

You may exercise the following rights under the conditions and within the limits set forth in the applicable regulations:

- the right to access your personal data as processed by us and, if you
 believe that any information relating to you is incorrect, obsolete or
 incomplete, to request its correction or updating;
- the right to request the erasure of your personal data or the restriction thereof to specific categories of processing;
- the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing before such withdrawal;
- the right to object, in whole or in part, to the processing of your personal data;
- the right to object to a channel of communication used for direct marketing purposes; and

• the right to request its portability, i.e. that the personal data you have provided to us be returned to you or transferred to the person of your choice, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format without hindrance from us and subject to your confidentiality obligations.
